HSE Committee (Health, Safety and Environment, includes river clean-up) - Duties include water safety and boating, water quality, encouragement of fishing, tree protection, debris removal, protection of shoreline, growth of noxious vegetation (algae in the water), and enhancement of the lake, etc. Will also aim at working with GBRA to promote some or all of the above duties. Chair: Tim Bays

Communications & Public Relations Committee - Will handle Facebook postings, email notifications, publicity, updates to members, possible website and any public relations. Co-Chairs: Sydney Burton & Janet Hudson

Communications: Communicate updates to members, keep/update a roster of all members and handle publicity. Will work closely with web communications and President to coordinate updates to members, notify board members and officers of meetings planned and any events (ex. City Council) where all members will be attending and send out notifications.

Web Communications: Christy Sellers - Facebook postings and possible website.

Public Relations: Miriam Jones - Manages how information about MLNDA and its activities is spread to the public. Will work with other lake associations and organizations such as the Save Our Lakes Coalition.

Association Fundraising Committee – Raise funds for the association through event planning, merchandise, etc. Chair: Molly Kelley

GBRA Committee – Official contact with GBRA. The chair and/or president/vice presidents should strive to represent MLNDA at all GBRA meetings. All official contact with GBRA will funnel through the chair to keep clear lines of communication. Chair: Janet Hudson

Technical Committee on Dam Construction – Evaluate all gate replacement options and investigate the lowest life cycle cost option that is technically acceptable. Continue to stay involved and represent MLNDA interests during the engineering, procurement and construction of the gate. Chair: Jacy Robbins

Financing Committee for Dam Construction – Will look into any and all funding options for the dam including, but not limited to: city, county and state funding; power sales from hydroelectricity; water control improvement district (WCID); municipal bonds; donations; SEDC; C of C; Federal Government (FEMA); grants from environmental groups; etc. Chair: Miriam Jones

Membership Committee - To support in spreading the word for the addition of more members. We need all members to be involved with this. Chair: Janet Hudson

Executive Committee – Made up of all officers.
